

GRAND TOUR OF AUSTRIA



1st DAY Vienna

Arrival in Vienna, after placement in the rooms, dinner and overnight-stay.

2nd DAY Vienna

The entire day, with lunch in the restaurant, will be dedicated to the tour through the city (morning along the Ring Boulevard and historical centre, afternoon in the castle Schönbrunn), Abendessen in einem typischen Restaurant with music at Grinzing/Neustift.

3rd DAY Vienna-Klagenfurt

4th DAY Klagenfurt-Innsbruk

Klagenfurt - Innsbruck

This way leads along the lake Wörther, as next comes the Velden and Villach in the direction of Großglockner, the highest peak of the eastern Alps (3797 m height)

A short break on the Hochtor (on about 2500 m height), with a beautiful view over eastern Alps, where you can have lunch (in case that the time run out, in direction of Lienz and Gallery Felbtauern).

In the afternoon we continue to Mittersill and Kizbühel and to Inntal all over to the Innsbruck, the capital of the province Tyrol.

Dinner at the hotel.

In the evening you can see the traditional folkloristic Event (selective)

Overnight-stay at the hotel that you choose.

5 th DAY Innsbruk-Salzburg

In the morning, tour through the city including the winter Olympics ski-jump area and the Wilten basilica, a walk through the historical centre of Innsbruck with visit of the golden roof and imperial church with the grave of Kaiser Maximilian I. Selective lunch.

In the afternoon we continue to Salzburg, over the Wörgl and Lofer, through the small German triangle (24 km from Germany). Dinner and overnight-stay at the selected hotel.

6 th DAY Salzburg

In the morning, after breakfast, visit of one of the most impressive cities, after the opinion of Alexander von Humboldt, famous German explorer. You will see the house of Mozart, the famous Getreidegasse and many other famous streets, in one of the most famous cities in the world, especially because of its music festivals.

Afternoon is free so you will have the opportunity to visit the fortress Hohensalzburg, from where you can enjoy in a beautiful over the city or you can visit the castle Hellbrunn.

Dinner and overnight-stay at the hotel.

7 th DAY Salzburg-Vienna

After the breakfast, departure from Salzburg to Vienna, over the lake region Salzkammergut (lake Fuschl, lake Wolfgang), after that over Bad Ischl to Melk.

Possibility to visit the monastery (selective), lunch to select.

We will make a cruise along the Danube in the afternoon, through Wachau, which is famous for wine cultivation and apricot cultivation to the Dürnstein. Return to Vienna.

8 th DAY Vienna

After breakfast, meeting with the tour guide, visit of the House of Hundertwasser (house of the famous Austrian architect), then we come to the Danube over the Prater where you can see the Giant Ferris Wheel. We continue to the New Vienna, where is situated the UN-City, after that we will visit the Danube Tower and after a way up of 140 meters we will have lunch in a rotatable restaurant on a tower.

After lunch we will visit the Viennese forest – Mayerling – Monastery of the Holy Cross.

A trip that will bring you in the surroundings of Vienna, where you can see the sights such as Viennese forest, thermal springs Baden, Helenetal, Mayerling, the old hunt museum (today a memorial chapel), where Prince Rudolf, the only son of Josef and Sissy, committed suicide together with Baroness Vetsera.

At the Monastery of the Holy Cross you will visit the church and the medieval cloister.

You will pass the Holdrichsmühle, where Franz Schubert wrote his song "Under the linden" and so you will get to the lake grotto, where you can see the biggest subterranean lake.

On the way to the Vienna, you will drive past the castle of Lichtenstein.

You will spend the evening in a typical bar in the centre and after that you will see a concert with Viennese Waltz
